St. Monica (Feast Day: August 27)

St. Augustine (Feast Day: August 28)

The circumstances of St. Monica’s life could have made her a nagging wife, a bitter daughter-in-law and a despairing parent, yet she did not give way to any of these temptations. Although she was a Christian, her parents gave her in marriage to a pagan, Patricius, who lived in her hometown of Tagaste in North Africa. Patricius had some redeeming features, but he had a violent temper and was licentious. Monica also had to bear with a cantankerous mother-in-law who lived in her home. Patricius criticized his wife because of her charity and piety, but always respected her. Monica’s prayers and example finally won her husband and mother-in-law to Christianity. Her husband died in 371, one year after his baptism.

Monica had at least three children who survived infancy. The oldest, Augustine, is the most famous. At the time of his father’s death, Augustine was 17 and a rhetoric student in Carthage. Monica was distressed to learn that her son had accepted the Manichean heresy and was living an immoral life. For a while, she refused to let him eat or sleep in her house. Then one night she had a vision that assured her Augustine would return to the faith. From that time on she stayed close to her son, praying and fasting for him. In fact, she often stayed much closer than Augustine wanted.

When he was 29, Augustine decided to go to Rome to teach rhetoric. Monica was determined to go along. One night he told his mother that he was going to the dock to say goodbye to a friend. Instead, he set sail for Rome. Monica was heartbroken when she learned of Augustine’s trick, but she still followed him. She arrived in Rome only to find that he had left for Milan. Although travel was difficult, Monica pursued him to Milan. In Milan, Augustine came under the influence of the bishop, St. Ambrose, who also became Monica’s spiritual director. She accepted his advice in everything and had the humility to give up some practices that had become second nature to her. Monica became a leader of the devout women in Milan as she had been in Tagaste.

She continued her prayers for Augustine during his years of instruction. At Easter, 387, St. Ambrose baptized Augustine and several of his friends. Soon after, his party left for Africa. Although no one else was aware of it, Monica knew her life was near the end. She told Augustine, “*Son, nothing in this world now affords me delight. I do not know what there is now left for me to do or why I am still here, all my hopes in this world being now fulfilled.*” She became ill shortly after and suffered severely for nine days before her death. Her dying words to her son were, “*Remember me at the Altar.*”

Commento al Vangelo

Quando Gesù chiese ai suoi discepoli: "La gente chi dice che sia il Figlio dell'uomo?", le loro risposte rispecchiarono le diverse teorie e speculazioni riguardo Gesù diffuse nella loro cultura. Se la stessa domanda fosse posta da Gesù oggi, le risposte sembrerebbero forse più colte, ma sarebbero molto simili. Invece di evocare Elia, Giovanni Battista o Geremia, si evocherebbero forse le speculazioni dell'ultimo convegno sulla cristologia, oppure ancora i risultati di un recente sondaggio. Possiamo immaginare che Gesù ascolterebbe gentilmente, forse sorridendo.

Poi però giunge la vera e propria domanda: "Voi chi dite che io sia?". Non possiamo più rifugiarsi dietro ad opinioni di altri, siano essi teologi o conduttori di dibattiti televisivi. Gesù vuole la nostra risposta personale. Dobbiamo prendere posizione personalmente nei suoi confronti. È quello che succede con l'atto di fede. Gesù lancia una sfida a ogni uomo e a ogni donna direttamente e personalmente: "Tu, chi dici che io sia?". La nostra risposta possa essere quella di Pietro: "Tu sei il Cristo, il figlio del Dio vivente". La nostra risposta possa essere quella della Chiesa, che fu fondata da Cristo su Pietro come su una pietra, affinché il "credo" diventasse un "crediamo": Crediamo in Dio, Padre onnipotente..., in un solo Signore Gesù Cristo, unigenito Figlio di Dio..., per opera dello Spirito Santo... incarnato nel seno della Vergine Maria.

Homilía, domingo 27 de Agosto, XXI (A) del tiempo ordinario

Texto del Evangelio (Mt 16,13-20):

En aquel tiempo, al llegar a la región de Cesárea de Filipo, Jesús hizo esta pregunta a sus discípulos: «¿Quién dicen los hombres que es el Hijo del hombre?». Ellos dijeron: «Unos, que Juan el Bautista; otros, que Elías, otros, que Jeremías o uno de los profetas». Él les dijo: «Y vosotros, ¿quién decís que soy yo?». Simón Pedro contestó: «Tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios vivo». Replicando Jesús le dijo: «Bienaventurado eres Simón, hijo de porque no te ha revelado esto la carne ni la sangre, sino mi Padre que está en los cielos. Y yo a mi vez te digo que "tú eres Pedro, y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia, y las puertas del infierno no prevalecerán contra ella. A ti te daré las llaves del Reino de los Cielos; y lo que ates en la tierra quedará atado en los cielos, y lo que desates en la tierra quedará desatado en los cielos». Entonces mandó a sus discípulos que no dijese a nadie que Él era el Cristo.

« (...). Y ustedes ¿quién decís que soy yo?»


Hoy, la profesión de fe de Pedro en Cesárea de Filipo abre la última etapa del ministerio público de Jesús preparándonos al acontecimiento supremo de su muerte y resurrección. Después de la multiplicación de los panes y los peces, Jesús decide retirarse por un tiempo con sus apóstoles para intensificar su formación. En ellos empieza hacerse visible la Iglesia, semilla del Reino de Dios en el mundo.

Hace dos domingos, al contemplar como Pedro andaba sobre las aguas y se hundía en ellas, escuchábamos la reprensión de Jesús: «¡Qué poca fe! ¿Por qué has dudado?» (Mt 14,31). Hoy, la reconvención se cambia en un elogio: «Bienaventurado eres Simón, hijo de Jonás» (Mt 16,17). Pedro es dichoso porque ha abierto su corazón a la revelación divina y ha reconocido en Jesucristo al Hijo de Dios Salvador. A lo largo de la historia se nos plantean las mismas preguntas: «¿Quién dicen los hombres que es el Hijo del hombre? (...). Y vosotros, ¿quién decís que soy yo?» (Mt 16,13.15). También nosotros, en un momento u otro, hemos tenido que responder quién es Jesús para mí y qué reconozco en Él; de una fe recibida y transmitida por unos testigos (padres, catequistas, sacerdotes, maestros, amigos...) hemos pasado a una fe personalizada en Jesucristo, de la que también nos hemos convertido en testigos, ya que en eso consiste el núcleo esencial de la fe cristiana. Solamente desde la fe y la comunión con Jesucristo venceremos el poder del mal. El Reino de la muerte se manifiesta entre nosotros, nos causa sufrimiento y nos plantea muchos interrogantes; sin embargo, también el Reino de Dios se hace presente en medio de nosotros y desvela la esperanza; y la Iglesia, sacramento del Reino de Dios en el mundo, cimentada en la roca de la fe confesada por Pedro, nos hace nacer a la esperanza y a la alegría de la vida eterna. Mientras haya humanidad en el mundo, será preciso dar esperanza, y mientras sea preciso dar esperanza, será necesaria la misión de la Iglesia; por

eso, el poder del infierno no la derrotará, ya que Cristo, presente en su pueblo, así nos lo garantiza. Oremos hoy por nuestro papa Francisco, que es Pedro en la Iglesia. Feliz domingo
