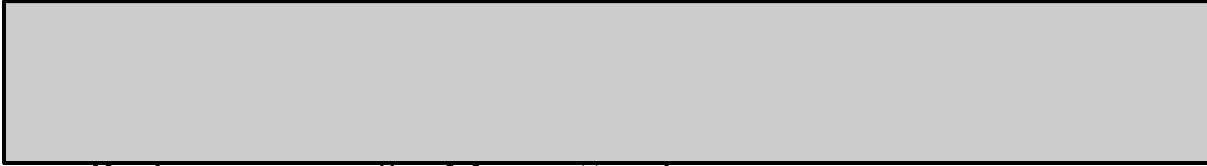

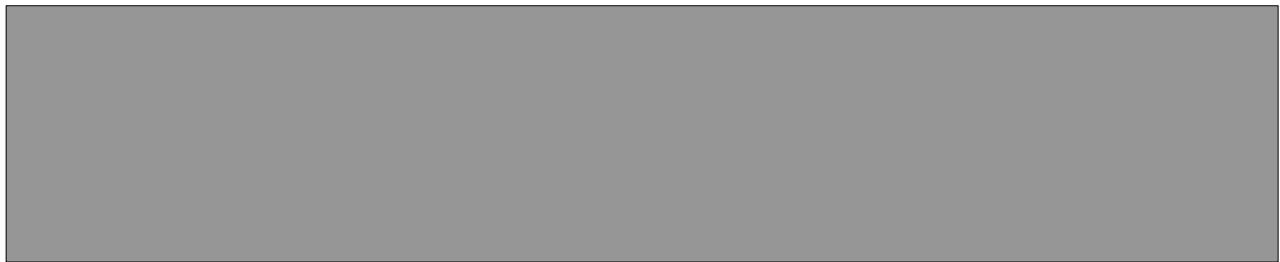

Non molto tempo fa Gesù aveva chiamato Pietro felice, ora la sua reazione è drammatica, dice: "Distanza da me Satana, perché mi hai messo in pericolo di cadere! Non vedi le cose come Dio li vede, ma come gli uomini li vedono! "

Perché Gesù tratta con tanta forza Pietro?

C'è nella lingua del Signore un certo intreccio da comprendere. Ogni cosa umana acquista da Dio un significato diverso. Quando pensiamo che questo o che la vita è una vergogna, umanamente parlando, dobbiamo vedere il significato spirituale più profondo che c'è dato di conoscere la volontà di Dio per la nostra esistenza.

Il vero seguace di Gesù segue il dolore per seguirlo in onore. Il cristiano segue Gesù non il contrario.

Quali sono le condizioni per essere un seguace di Gesù?

1. Negare se stessi: dimenticare se stessi. Si sta dicendo che ci sono tutti noi e porta ad essere egocentrico, autonomo e autosufficiente, non vogliamo seguire i nostri piani, e nostri interessi, ma dipendiamo da tutto da Dio e da fare e soffrire tutto ciò che Egli ha per noi.

Inutile dire che ho il più grande ostacolo per trovare e seguire Dio nella nostra vita non sono altri, né le circostanze della vita ... il più grande ostacolo è noi stessi. Dobbiamo ricondurre il nostro sé a Cristo e lasciare che Dio ci guida.

2. E' il nostro unico che ci lega e ci fa vedere le cose che ci sono e si sentono le cose che non sono reali. La fede ci aiuta a rieducare il sé.

Prendi la tua croce: non si riferisce ai problemi della vita che ci appaiono ovunque ... è quello di assumere l'onere del sacrificio. Il seguace di Gesù deve entrare nella linea di quelli condannati a morte ai desideri di se stessi. La croce è l'onere che dobbiamo volontariamente servire per servire il vangelo del Signore.

3. Dobbiamo prendere la croce e seguirla con Cristo. Non dovremmo attraversare noi stessi, ma portare la spalla a cui Dio ha preparato, senza temere il suo peso, senza essere pieni di paure.

Per seguirlo è andare al ritmo di Dio nella nostra vita.

La comprensione di queste tre parti è fondamentale per vivere il Vangelo con una certa eleganza. Alla fine ci viene promesso una ricompensa ...

Ciclo A Mt 16, 21-27 "El que quiera venirse conmigo que se niegue a si mismo"

Se dice que la autoestima es importantísima para el desarrollo de la persona. Cuando una persona no se reafirma como tal es como un ser humano a medio hacer que no ha llegado a su plenitud. Hoy la Palabra parece proponernos justo lo contrario.

Jesús empieza a hablar a sus discípulos abiertamente. Les habla del sufrimiento y de la muerte que le esperan y les indica también la presencia de su resurrección. Para algunos esto puede parecer como la fatalidad del destino donde, según dice, cada persona tiene su vida escrita... Los cristianos no creemos en el destino ni que nuestra vida esté escrita en sitio alguno. Creemos en la libertad de la persona desde donde tomamos opciones para nuestra existencia que nos conducen a la felicidad o la frustración.

Ahora el Señor les habla de lo que le esperaba porque ya ellos están preparados para escuchar. Pedro hacía un momento había declarado en nombre de todos el reconocimiento de Jesús como el Mesías. Cuando los discípulos fueron capaces de reconocerle es cuando comienza a hablarles claro.

¿Por qué Jesús trata con tanta dureza a Pedro?

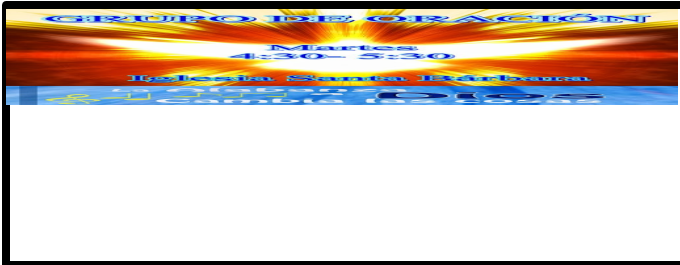
