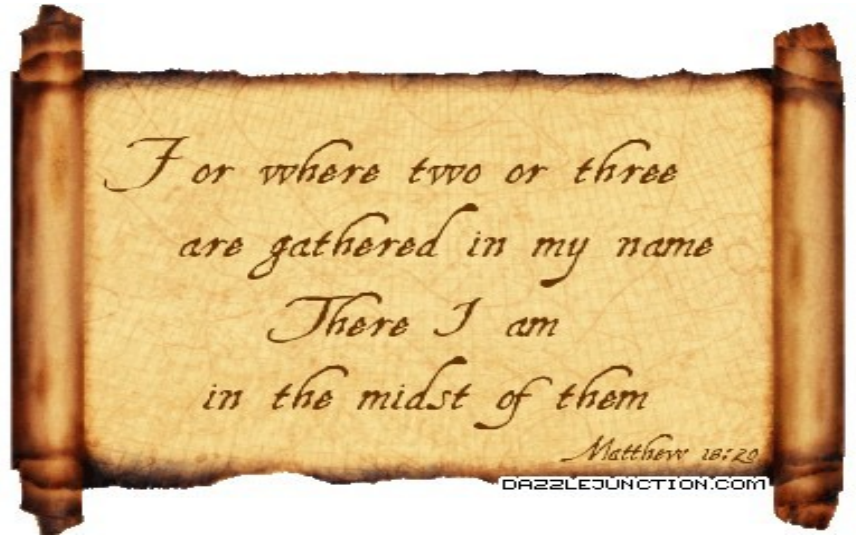

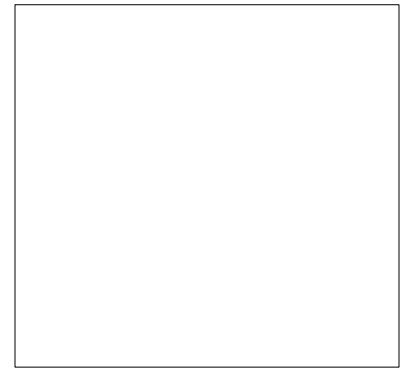

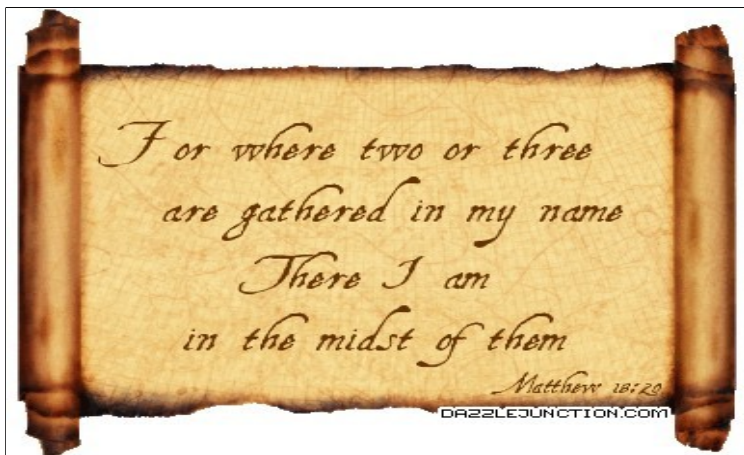

"Prima di correggere il fratello, guardiamo prima i nostri difetti e li correggiamo"

Tutti, a molti modi, hanno un ideale. Ognuno, a un certo punto della nostra vita, ha voluto raggiungere obiettivi elevati. Tutti, a un certo punto, abbiamo cercato di cercare la perfezione e la fuga dalla mediocrità o dalle cose rimaste a metà. E in tutto questo; negli ideali, negli obiettivi e nel perseguimento della perfezione, abbiamo capito che non siamo sempre stati alti e che, per raggiungere la fine, abbiamo dovuto correggere ciò che non era buono per i nostri scopi. Oppure no? Vale la pena di iniziare un viaggio sapendo che, in tasca, non abbiamo abbastanza per affrontare le spese? - È bene, per noi e per coloro che ci circondano, bloccarci nelle nostre carenze e vantiamo di quello che sappiamo sugli errori di fondo? - Perché spesso pensiamo che la conversione o il cambiamento devono essere fatti da altri e non nella nostra vita? Gesù, nel Vangelo di questa Domenica, ci offre alcuni indizi molto degni di essere presi in considerazione:

In primo luogo, la correzione fraterna non significa modellare la gente al nostro capriccio. Quante volte crediamo di avere il diritto di sottolineare le debolezze degli altri e nascondere la nostra. Il Signore ci indica la via e il senso autentico della correzione fraterna: cercare che i nostri fratelli e sorelle possano essere in comunione con Dio. In secondo luogo, il nostro obiettivo come cristiani non è quello di giudicare o proclamare dal tetto delle nostre parole, posizione o privilegi, gli atteggiamenti o la vita degli altri. La nostra preghiera, la nostra missione o la nostra sfida devono essere esattamente che gli altri ritrovano la verità di Dio. Terzo, quello di "me" non è né buono né caratteristico di una vita cristiana. I problemi degli altri, anche se ci sembra un'intrusione, devono anche essere nostri. Non possiamo vivere indifferenti alla sofferenza di coloro che ci circondano. Essere cristiani è condividere gioia e tristezza, gioia e lacrime, successo e fallimento con tutti.

Costa, e molto, correggere e correggere. correggere; perché c'è sempre il rischio di perdere amici, essere picchiati. Correggiamo, perché la nostra fede non è sempre colta abbastanza per fare o ricevere una correzione. È solo dal comando dell'amore, dal desiderio di incontrare Gesù, che la correzione è intesa come un modo che ci porta ad un incontro personale e autentico con Gesù e per migliorare il nostro rapporto con gli altri. Viviamo in una società in cui i difetti della Chiesa non si sfogano come una chiamata al cambiamento o alla riflessione, ma come distruzione. Inoltre, intorno a noi, con il nostro modo di giudicare situazioni e persone, possiamo cadere nella stessa tentazione: vogliamo sottomettere o distruggere chi non ci piace. E non è una correzione, fraterna o cristiana, ma annihlazione dell'avversario. Che dalla forza che ci dona la preghiera, siamo in grado di guardare la nostra vita e di promuovere le comunità e le famiglie cristiane più autentiche e riconciliate. La nostra fede cresca in modo tale che vorremmo e accogliamo la correzione come un cammino verso la santità e l'unità. La promessa di Gesù è questa: "Se due o tre accettano di chiedere qualcosa, mio padre li darà loro: dove due o tre sono riuniti nel mio nome, io sono tra loro".

Para La Comunidad Hispana

XXIII Domingo Sept.10 (San Mateo 18, 15-20)

"Antes de corregir al hermano, miremos primero nuestros defectos y corriámoslos"

Todos, en muchos aspectos, tenemos un ideal. Todos, en algún momento de nuestra vida, hemos anhelado llegar a metas altas. Todos, en algún instante, hemos intentado buscar la perfección y escapar de la mediocridad o de las cosas dejadas a medias. Y, en todo ello; en los ideales, metas y búsqueda de la perfección, nos hemos dado cuenta que no siempre hemos estado a la altura y que, para llegar hasta el final, hemos tenido que corregir aquello que no era bueno para lograr nuestros propósitos. ¿O no? **¿Sirve de algo iniciar un viaje** sabiendo que, en el bolsillo, no tenemos lo suficiente para hacer frente a los gastos?- **¿Es bueno, para nosotros y para los que nos rodean,** encerrarnos en nuestros defectos y presumir de lo que sabemos son en el fondo errores?- **¿Por qué, con frecuencia, pensamos que la conversión** o el cambio lo tienen que realizar los demás y no en nuestra vida? Jesús, en el evangelio de este domingo, nos ofrece unas pistas que son muy dignas de ser tenidas en cuenta:

Primero: la corrección fraterna no significa el modelar las personas a nuestro antojo. Cuántas veces nos creemos con derecho a apuntar las debilidades de los demás y a ocultar las nuestras. El Señor nos indica el camino y el sentido auténtico de la corrección fraterna: buscar que nuestros hermanos estén en comunión con Dios.

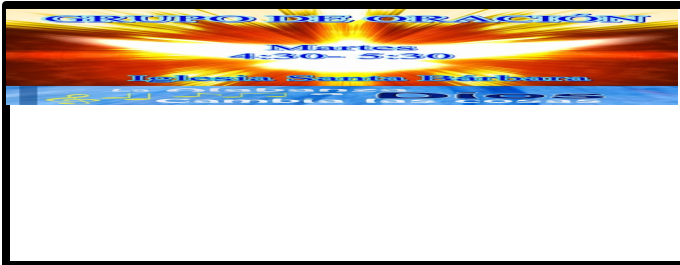
Segundo: nuestro objetivo, como cristianos, no es juzgar ni pregonar desde la azotea de nuestras palabras, posición o privilegios, las actitudes o vida de los demás. Nuestra oración, nuestra misión o nuestro reto debe ser precisamente el que los demás encuentren la verdad de Dios. **Tercero:** aquello de "a mí" no es bueno ni característico de una vida cristiana. Los problemas de los demás, aunque nos parezca una intromisión, deben de ser también los nuestros. No podemos vivir indiferentes al sufrimiento de los que nos rodean. Ser cristiano es compartir la alegría y la tristeza, el gozo y el llanto, el éxito y el fracaso con todos.

Cuesta, y mucho, corregir y ser corregido. Corregir; porque siempre hay riesgo de perder amigos, ser agredidos. Ser corregido, porque nuestra fe no siempre está suficiente cultivada como para hacer o recibir una corrección. Sólo, desde el mandamiento del amor, desde el deseo de encontrarnos con Jesús, es cuando, la corrección es entendida como un camino, que nos lleva al encuentro personal y auténtico con Jesús y mejorar nuestra relación con los demás. Vivimos en una sociedad donde, los defectos de la Iglesia, son aireados no como llamada al cambio o la reflexión, sino como destrucción. También, a nuestro alrededor, con nuestra forma de enjuiciar situaciones y personas, podemos caer en la misma tentación: querer someter, o destruir a quien no nos agrada. Y eso no es corrección, fraterna o cristiana, sino, aniquilación del adversario. Que desde la fuerza que nos da la oración, seamos capaces de mirar nuestra propia vida, y fomentar comunidades y familias cristianas más auténticas y reconciliadas. Que, nuestra fe vaya creciendo de tal manera, que gustemos y acojamos la corrección como un camino hacia la santidad, y unidad.
