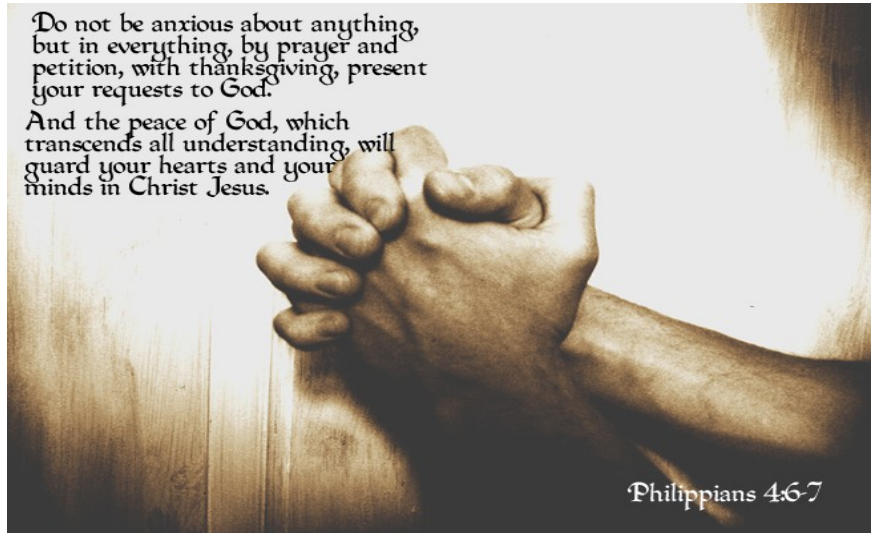

our Lord. Very often farms and vineyards were owned by foreigners and wealthy Israelites. If the workmen were to take over the farm or vineyard they would be considered to be in rebellion. In addition to this a Jewish law read that if a landowner died without an heir, the property went to the first person to claim it; in the case of the parable the workmen. The vineyard in this parable is a source of great turmoil because the workers were keeping the fruit for themselves. The workmen here are the elders and leaders of the Jewish people. They were more concerned about their own status and power than in the work of God's kingdom. Politically these leaders were winning concessions from the Roman emperor that would keep them in power and financially sound. These leaders were afraid they would be thrown into poverty if they lost their positions; for them this was not a good time for a rebellion, it was not a good time for a Messiah.

The world was ready. God was ready.

Over 800 years ago a man was born who embraced the attitude of bearing fruit for God's kingdom that he reformed the entire Church. His influence is still felt today. Our Pope bears his name. I am speaking about St Francis of Assisi, whose feast we celebrated last Wednesday. St Francis knew that the trappings of power, possessions and greed would lead people to behave just like those workmen in the parable. St Francis by his example reminds us that we need to hear God's call in our life. We need to recognize that the greatest wealth we could ever possess is the love of God. We then need to put this love into action, spreading the Gospel of Jesus to all people. Vintage time is upon us. The owner of the vineyard is looking for the fruits of our labor. Do we have the courage to put the Lord and his kingdom first in our lives and in our world? We gather here in church every Sunday seeking the courage to be the Lord's laborer in his vineyard.

Per la Comunità Italiana

DOMENICA XXVI. (Matteo 21,33-43)

Gesù a pochi giorni dalla Pasqua, rivolge la parabola dei due figli, insieme a quella dei *vignaioli omicidie*, ai capi religiosi del suo tempo, che avevano assunto un atteggiamento di incredulità e di rifiuto nei suoi confronti. Essi si erano chiusi nelle sicurezze e certezze che derivavano loro dall'osservanza della legge, e non avevano voluto riconoscere Gesù come l'inviato di Dio. Il modo in cui vivevano il loro sì alla legge li portò a dire no al vangelo. Invece i peccatori, e prima di tutto gli odiati pubblicani e prostitute, avevano accolto Gesù e la sua parola. Gesù dichiara che i peccatori prendono il posto di quelli che si considerano giusti e quindi candidati del regno di Dio. Egli infatti afferma che il regno di Dio è misericordia e perdono, perciò i peccatori ne sono i primi destinatari.

Ognuno deve rispondere solo delle sue colpe attuali e personali, non di quelle dei suoi padri; inoltre, mediante la conversione il peccatore può evitare il castigo... CHE COSA DOBBIAMO FARE?...

1) *Umiltà*: "Un uomo aveva due figli". Tutti noi, siamo figli di Dio, e nessuno è perfetto, e abbiamo svagliato poco o molto: chi è infedele nelle parole, chi nei fatti, nessuno dice "sì" e poi va a lavorare, tutti facciamo peccati. Non esiste qualcuno esente da macchie, quindi abilitato a disprezzare l'altro: tutti siamo peccatori ("il giusto pecca sette volte al giorno" cf Pr 24,16). E' un grande invito all'umiltà, sull'esempio di Gesù: *"Avbate gli stessi sentimenti di Cristo Gesù ...che svuotò se stesso, umiliò stesso facendosi obbediente fino alla morte e a una morte di croce. Ciascuno di voi, con tutta umiltà, consideri gli altri superiori a se stesso"* (Seconda lettura Fil 2,7-8)

2) *Pentirsi*: "Il figlio disse 'non ne ho voglia'. Ma poi si pentì e vi andò". Il pentimento è riconoscersi lontani da Dio, ma appartenenti a Lui. Nella prima lettura il profeta Ezechiele esorta tutti: il giusto a perseverare fino alla fine sulla strada del bene ("non dire: e se provassi a?, e il malvagio a convertirsi (non dire: "domani). Alla base del pentimento, della conversione vi è la fede: i pubblicani e le prostitute hanno creduto nella predicazione di Giovanni Battista. *Credere significa sentirsi, anche nella notte più oscura della nostra vita, appartenenti a Dio Padre, "sempre pronto ad accogliere pubblicani e peccatori appena si dispongono a pentirsi di cuore"*. Solo se credo in Qualcuno che mi ama, posso cercare di cambiare vita, il pentimento a partire da me, non ha radici. Il peccato non è tanto un'infrazione ad una legge, ma una ferita ad una persona che mi ama e mi viene sempre a cercare per donarmi la felicità: Gesù di Nazaret! Solo chi si sente amato dal Signore, e crede a questo amore, può pentirsi e ricevere una nuova vita.

3) *Essere migliore*: "I pubblicani e le prostitute vi passano avanti nel Regno di Dio" (Mt 21,31).. Gesù invita ad uno sguardo più profondo. I capi del popolo hanno ascoltato la predicazione del Battista e anche la conversione dei peccatori, ma non si sono pentiti da credergli. Il Signore rimprovera "i bravi" di aver visto cose grandi, ma di non aver cambiato nulla, così potrebbe essere della nostra vita: spesso il Signore veramente opera meraviglie, ma il nostro cuore è lontano, freddo, incapace di uno slancio. *Coltiviamo i sentimenti di Gesù per dire "sì" nelle parole e nei fatti. Gesù si è svuotato della propria divinità per testimoniarcì come vivere in pienezza la nostra umanità*. La sua è stata una vita umana vera, buona, fedele al Padre e ai fratelli, ricca di parole seguita dai fatti, a noi spetta lasciarci innamorare da questa bellezza! Coraggio il Signore ci aspetta nella sua vigna!

Para La Comunidad Hispana

DOMINGO XXVI. (Mateo 21: 33-43)

Jesús, pocos días después de la Pascua, se dirige a la parábola de los dos hijos, junto con el de los inquilinos omicidie, a religiosi líderes de su época, que había tomado una actitud de incredulidad y rechazo de él. Ellos fueron cerradas en la seguridad y certeza que se derivan de la observancia de la ley, y no quieren reconocer a Jesús como el enviado de Dios. La forma en que vivieron su sí a la ley les llevó a decir no al Evangelio. En lugar de pecadores, y en primer lugar odiados publicistas y prostitutas, había acogido a Jesús y su palabra. Jesús declara que los pecadores toman el lugar de los que se consideran justos, y por lo tanto los candidatos del reino de Dios. De hecho, se dice que el reino de la misericordia y el perdón de Dios, por lo que los pecadores son los primeros receptores. Todo el mundo debe responder sólo sus defectos actuales y personales, no los de sus padres; Además, por la conversión, el pecador puede evitar el castigo ... ¿QUÉ TENEMOS QUE HACER? ...

Humildad: Un hombre tuvo dos hijos: "Todos nosotros somos hijos de Dios, y nadie es perfecto, y hemos corrido poco o mucho, que es infiel en palabras, que en realidad nadie dice" sí "y luego va para trabajar, todos hacemos pecados. No hay nadie libre de manchas, tan empoderados para despreciar al otro: todos somos pecadores ("el justo mata siete veces al día", Pr 24:16). Es una gran invitación a la humildad, en el ejemplo de Jesús: "Tengan los mismos sentimientos que Cristo Jesús ... que se vació, se humilló haciéndose obediente a la muerte ya la muerte de una cruz. Cada uno de vosotros, con toda humildad, considera a los demás superiores a sí mismo "(Segunda Lectura Fil 2,7-8)

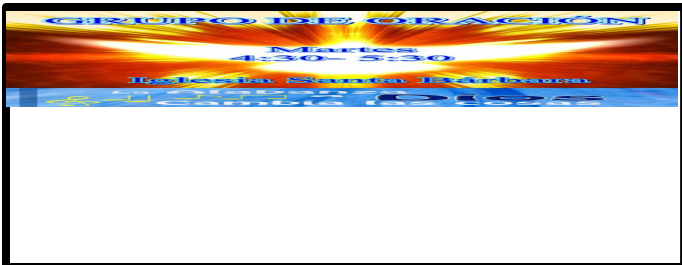
2) Arrepentirse: "El hijo dijo, 'no quiero' Pero luego se arrepintió y fue.." El arrepentimiento es reconocer lejos de Dios, sino que pertenecen a él en la primera lectura, el profeta Ezequiel insta a todos:.. El derecho a perseverar hasta el final del camino del bien ("?" no digo, y si he intentado, y los malvados al arrepentimiento (por no decir:" Mañana) en la base del arrepentimiento, la conversión es la fe:.. los publicanos y las ramerías creyeron en la predicación de Giovanni Battista. creer significa sentir, incluso en la noche oscura de nuestras vidas, que pertenece a Dios el Padre, "siempre dispuesta a recibir y pecadores tan pronto como usted tiene que arrepentirse de corazón." Sólo si usted cree en Alguien que me ama, puedo tratar de cambiar sus vidas, el arrepentimiento de mí, que no tiene raíces pecado no es tanto una violación de una ley, pero una lesión a una persona que me ama y yo siempre tratar de dar la felicidad:.. Jesús de Nazaret! Sólo aquellos que me sienten los del Señor, y creen en este amor, pueden arrepentirse y recibir una nueva vida.

3) Mejor: "Los publicanos y las prostitutas pasan al Reino de Dios" (Mt 21,31) Jesús invita a una mirada más profunda. Los líderes del pueblo oyeron la predicación del Bautista y también la conversión de los pecadores, pero no se arrepintieron de creerle. El Señor le reprocha el "bien" por haber visto grandes cosas, pero no haber cambiado nada, así puede ser de nuestras vidas: a menudo el Señor realmente hace maravillas, pero nuestro corazón está lejos, frío, incapaz de un impulso.
