

Sacrament of Baptism: *English:* Parents planning to have a child baptized must first call the Rectory during office hours to schedule an appointment for the Baptismal intake. Intakes will take place at the Rectory on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month. This must take place 1 month prior to Baptism. Baptisms are celebrated on the 2nd Sunday of every month at 2:45PM. Sacrament of Marriage: Arrangements must be made with a priest/deacon at least 6 months prior to the wedding date.

invite to my wedding. My list totaled about 100 people. This list was carefully scrutinized by my parents. The list began to be altered. The usual scenario took place. "You have to invite so and so because we were invited to their daughter's wedding." I had no idea who so and so was. When I coordinated with my wife, I found that her list was over 250 people. I was told to shorten my list. This was not an easy thing to do; after many hard fought arguments a final list was prepared. Those that were invited enjoyed a great feast.

The Gospel today speaks about a wedding feast. Jesus again uses a parable to describe for all who would listen what the kingdom of heaven would be like. God wants all people to be in the kingdom of heaven. The parable states that some just refused the invitation, while others had to attend to other things happening in their lives. Simply put they have no time for God. This is not something that happened 2000 years ago; it seems in the modern culture that the importance of faith and going to mass has more or less disappeared for many of us. We create constant excuses for not finding time for God; the inability to prioritize things in our lives.

God has given us life and He wants us to enjoy ourselves in this life. By giving us life he is throwing us a banquet, a feast with the best of food and drink. He knows that we will make mistakes. He is prepared to forgive us through the death and resurrection of His son, Jesus. Ultimately we will be judged at the end of our lives. He will see our humanity in the humanity of His son. But that means we must come properly dressed to this feast, dressed that is in the wedding garment given to us by Jesus. It means putting on a garment of acceptance of all people, a garment of forgiveness, a garment of compassion, and most importantly a garment of love. Our destiny is to be invited to the wedding. The decision we make with our lives will determine our place at the banquet.

Gospel: Matthew 22:1-14

Jesus again in reply spoke to the chief priests and elders of the people in parables, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son. He dispatched his servants to summon the invited guests to the feast, but they refused to come. A second time he sent other servants, saying: "Behold, I have prepared my banquet, my calves and fattened cattle are killed, and everything is ready come to the feast." Some ignored the invitation and went away, one to his farm, another to his business. The rest laid hold of his servants, mistreated them, and killed them. The king was enraged and sent his troops, destroyed those murderers, and burned their city. Then he said to his servants, 'The feast is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy to come. Go out, therefore, into the main roads and invite to the feast whomever you find.' The servants went out into the streets and gathered all they found, bad and good alike, and the hall was filled with guests. But when the king came in to meet the guests, he saw a man there not dressed in a wedding garment. The king said to him, 'My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?' But he was reduced to silence. Then the king said to his attendants, 'Bind his hands and feet, and cast him into the darkness outside, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth.' Many are invited, but few are chosen."

Nel salmo, partendo da questa situazione di peccato, di incorrispondenza, si implora il Signore perché abbia pietà delle nostre incorrispondenze, dei nostri peccati, usi misericordia e ridoni vita. Questa preghiera è rafforzata da un serio proposito di essere fedeli al Signore, al suo amore: "da te più non ci allontaneremo, fa splendere il tuo volto e noi saremo salvi".

Ma la situazione diventa grave - secondo il vangelo - quando si mette in atto una ribellione a Dio, nella ricerca dei propri interessi. La parabola parla dei servi maltrattati e percossi, parla del figlio che viene ucciso (Gesù parla di sé: pensiamo con quanta commozione avrà parlato così esplicitamente della sua passione e morte). Quanti segni di Dio, quante persone mandate (i profeti) per aiutare, quanto amore in Gesù, Figlio del Padre venuto per salvare! La ribellione a Dio - nella illusione di costruire meglio la vita da soli - è la propria rovina. Dio offrirà sempre il suo amore, il suo regno sarà dato a un popolo che ne produca i frutti.

La lettera di Paolo ci aiuta ad affidarci a Dio e a vivere una vita nuova nella fede, una vita piena di buona testimonianza e di buoni frutti. "Non angustiatevi per nulla, ma in ogni circostanza presentate a Dio le vostre richieste con preghiere, suppliche e ringraziamenti. Tutto quello che è vero, quello che è nobile, quello che è giusto, quello che è puro, quello che è amabile, quello che è onorato, ciò che è virtù e merita lode, questo sia oggetto dei vostri pensieri".


