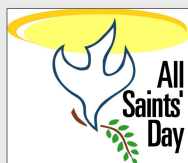

questions. There is even an app on the I-Phone called Siri; a voice activated search for answers to questions you may ask. However, some answers cannot be found, like the answer to the question my wife often asks, "How do I look in this dress?" There are questions about life that you will not find by using Google; "Why do I exist?" and "Why does evil exist in the world?" and my favorite, "Why are the Yankees the greatest team ever?" The Pharisees who questioned Jesus in today's Gospel reading were trying to get him to give a simple answer to the question that the scholars of Hebrew law debated: "What is the greatest of the commandments?" There were 613 of them in Hebrew Scripture. Which was the most important?

Jesus answered their question by using two quotations from the Torah; the Hebrew Scriptures. "Hear this, O Israel, the Lord thy God is one. You shall love thy God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with your entire mind." The second quotation is "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." This means you cannot love God just part of the time, when you feel the need to; we have to love Him with everything we have. We can't just be good to our neighbors sometimes, we have to be good to others all of the time; not just those people we like but all people.

Jesus' response did not only challenge the Pharisees, it challenges us over 2000 years later. Jesus' reply demanded a lifestyle change, a way of living that draws us so close to God that we become His presence to others. The poet Maya Angelou was once asked what her lifetime goals were. She answered that she wanted to become a Christian.

Maya Angelou was a Christian. Her point was that Christianity is an ongoing process of becoming. Every day we take steps to becoming a Christian.

And every day God uses people to find Him. We pray today that we might love God so deeply that we will have no choice but to bring God's love to those around us.

**“Am I called to be a Deacon”**

A Time to Gather & Pray to Begin the Inquiry

***What is a deacon? How do I become a deacon? How does my wife, family, parish and friends fit in?  
What does it mean to be “called?” What can I expect once I am ordained?***

**These are a few questions that will be addressed during the presentations.**

The purpose of this period of inquiry is to provide information to those men who feel they are being called to a vocation of diaconal ministry. Sessions will be held in two different locations in the diocese (Brooklyn and Queens) for men and their wives interested in learning more about diaconal ministry, the discernment of God’s call, the 5-year formation program, the life of a deacon, a wife’s place in her husband’s discernment and ministry, and the spiritual, intellectual, human and pastoral growth toward reception of the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

NOTE: To attend one of these sessions, men must first meet with their pastor to discuss their sense of God’s will for them. Then, they must register by committing to attend ONE of the following Inquiry Sessions AND a retreat day with their wife (if married). **Please note that the age to apply to formation is between 35 and 60 years old.**

## Per la Comunità Italiana

Prima, per mettere Gesù alla prova, i sadducei avevano fatto una domanda sulla fede nella risurrezione, ma furono duramente ripresi da Gesù (Mt 22,23-33). Ora sono i farisei che passano all'attacco. Farisei e sadducei erano nemici gli uni degli altri, ma diventano amici nella critica contro Gesù. I farisei si riuniscono ed uno di loro diventa porta parola con una domanda di chiarimento: "Maestro, qual'è il più grande comandamento della legge?" In quel tempo i giudei avevano una quantità enorme di norme, costumi e leggi, grandi e piccole, per regolamentare l'osservanza dei Dieci Comandamenti. Una discussione attorno a due comandamenti della legge di Dio era un punto molto discusso tra i farisei. Alcuni dicevano: "Tutte le leggi hanno lo stesso valore, siano grandi che piccole, perché tutte vengono da Dio. Non ci compete introdurre distinzioni nelle cose di Dio". Altri dicevano: "Alcune leggi sono più importanti di altre e, per questo, obbligano di più!" I farisei vogliono sapere qual'è l'opinione di Gesù su questo tema polemico.

Gesù risponde citando alcune parole della Bibbia: "Amerai il Signore Dio tuo con tutto il tuo cuore, con tutta la tua anima e con tutta la tua mente!" Al tempo di Gesù, i giudei che si consideravano pii recitavano questa frase tre volte al giorno: la mattina, a mezzogiorno e la sera. Era una preghiera assai conosciuta tra loro, come lo è oggi per noi il Padre Nostro. E Gesù cita di nuovo il Vecchio Testamento: "Questo è il più grande o il primo comandamento. Il secondo è simile a questo: Amerai il tuo prossimo come te stesso" (Lev 19,18). E conclude: "Da questi due comandamenti dipendono tutta la legge ed i profeti". Detto con altre parole, è questa la porta per arrivare a Dio ed al prossimo. Non ce n'è un'altra. La più grande tentazione dell'essere umano è quella di voler separare questi due amori, perché così la povertà degli altri non metterebbe a disagio la loro coscienza.

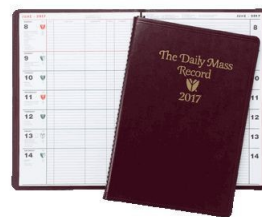

# Para La Comunidad Hispana

Antes, para poner a Jesús a prueba, los saduceos habían hecho una pregunta sobre la fe en la resurrección, pero fueron duramente refutados por Jesús (Mt 22,23-33). Ahora, son los fariseos los que pasan al ataque. Fariseos y saduceos eran enemigos entre sí, pero se convierten en amigos en la crítica contra Jesús. Los fariseos se reúnen y uno de ellos pasa a ser el portavoz con una pregunta de aclaración: "Maestro, ¿cuál es el más grande mandamiento de la ley?" En aquel tiempo los judíos tenían una cantidad enorme de normas, costumbres, leyes, grandes y pequeñas para regular la observancia de los Diez Mandamientos. Una discusión en torno a dos mandamientos de la ley de Dios era un punto muy discutido entre los fariseos. Unos decían: "Todas las leyes tienen el mismo valor, tanto las grandes como las pequeñas, porque todo viene de Dios. No nos compete introducir distinciones en las cosas de Dios". Otros decían: "Algunas leyes son más importantes que otras y por lo tanto más obligatorias". Los fariseos quieren saber la opinión de Jesús sobre este polémico tema.

Jesús responde citando algunas palabras de la Biblia: "¡Amarás al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma y con toda tu mente!" Al tiempo de Jesús, los judíos que se consideraban piadosos recitaban esta frase tres veces al día: por la mañana, a mediodía y por la tarde. Era una plegaria bastante conocida entre ellos, como lo es hoy para nosotros el *Padre Nuestro*. Y Jesús cita de nuevo el Viejo Testamento: "¡Éste es el más grande o el primer mandamiento. El segundo es semejante a éste: Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo". Y concluye: "De estos dos mandamientos penden toda la ley y los profetas". Dicho con otras palabras, ésta es la puerta para llegar a Dios y al prójimo. No existe otra. La más grande tentación del ser humano es la de querer separar estos dos amores, porque así la pobreza de los otros no inquietaría para nada su conciencia

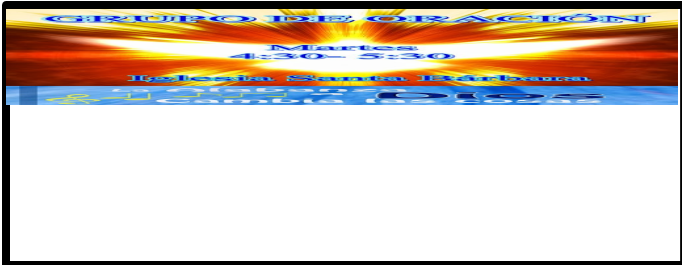
