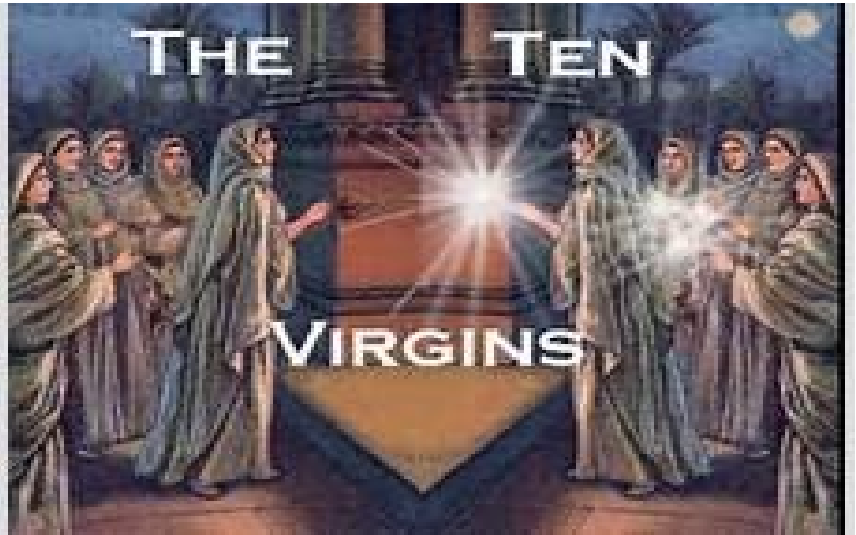

discouraging and depressing time. We are left with many questions; how could something like this happen? Why does God allow such evil to happen? There is no clear and simple answer except this; good and evil exist side by side with each other. God does not will that evil should prevail in our lives. God made us in His image. He made us to be happy in this world and to be happy with Him in the next life in heaven. We are the architects of our own destiny, endowed with the gift of free will. We can choose to do well or we can choose to be overwhelmed by the many temptations to fall short.

We must have faith; faith in Jesus. Jesus, who by His example, shows us how to live a life of love and a life of peace. He gives us hope. Hope that there will be peace, and an end to all violence.

Today's scriptures offer us hope. St Paul reminds us that if we have faith in Jesus we too will share in the hope of the resurrection. Everyone suffers sometime from bereavement, and some losses are especially hard to bear. But if we hope in the resurrection we need not grieve like others who have no hope.

Paul does not say we can avoid all sorrow, for sorrow over the death of a loved one is a natural and healthy reaction. What he says is not to be like others, who have no hope. Losing somebody in death causes us anguish, but hope of eternal life consoles us. The November liturgy suggests two things. First, it tells us to be prepared for passing on. People who live their lives close to Christ will not be unprepared to enter heaven. Secondly, it invites us to pray with love for those who have gone before us.

We believe that in death life is changed, not ended. This is our Christian hope; this is our God-given trust.

## Per la Comunità Italiana

Meditiamo la parabola delle dieci vergini, o delle dieci giovani ragazze. Nelle parabole Gesù ama usare fatti ben conosciuti della vita del popolo come mezzo di paragone per chiarire un aspetto sconosciuto del Regno di Dio. Nel caso della parabola delle dieci vergini, egli costruisce una storia attorno al comportamento differente delle ragazze che accompagnano lo sposo nel giorno di festa del matrimonio. Questo fatto ben noto a tutti è usato da Gesù per chiarire l'avvenimento dell'arrivo improvviso del Regno di Dio nella vita delle persone.

Generalmente Gesù non spiega le parabole, ma dice: "Chi ha orecchi per intendere intenda!" Ossia: "E' così. Avete udito! Ora cercate di capire." Egli provoca le persone, perché i fatti conosciuti nella vita quotidiana li aiutino a scoprire gli appelli di Dio nella loro vita. Egli coinvolge gli uditori nella scoperta del significato della parabola. L'esperienza che ciascuno ha del fatto di vita narrato nella parabola, contribuisce a scoprire il senso delle parole di Gesù. Segno che Gesù aveva fiducia nella capacità di comprensione delle persone. Essi diventano co-produttrici del significato. Alla fine della Parabola delle dieci vergini, Gesù dice: "Vigilate, dunque, perché non sapete né il giorno né l'ora." Questo avvertimento finale serve come chiave di lettura. Essa indica la direzione del pensiero di Gesù. Durante la lettura cercare di scoprire quale sia il punto centrale di questa parabola che serve a Gesù come similitudine con il Regno di Dio.



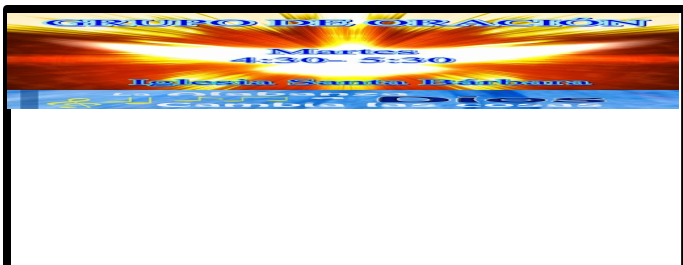

## Actitudes diferentes de las sabias y de las necias

Una vez despiertas, las jóvenes empiezan a preparar las lámparas que deben servir para alumbrar el camino. Había llegado la hora de echar más aceite, porque las lámparas se estaban extinguiendo. Las jóvenes que no tenían consigo aceite de reserva, piden aceite prestado a las otras. Estas responden que no pueden darles, porque al final faltaría para unas y otras. Si fuese sido solo para alumbrar el camino, las sabias hubieran podido decir: " Caminad junto a nosotras y veréis donde ponéis los pies". Pero no se trata de alumbrar el camino. Las lámparas servían también para festejar e iluminar la llegada del esposo. Este era el deber de las damas de honor: que cada una tuviese una lámpara encendida en la mano. En el momento de la crisis las jóvenes necias piden el compartir. Piden que las sabias compartan con ellas el aceite que han llevado. El compartir es una práctica muy importante y fundamental en la vida del pueblo de Dios. Pero aquí no se trata solo de compartir: porque si las prudentes hubieran compartido el aceite hubieran provocado daño al esposo, arruinando la fiesta de las bodas y hubieran terminado por no cumplir ni ellas ni las otras la tarea que habían asumido. Por esto las prudentes, de frente a la petición de las necias, responden que no pueden compartir y dan un consejo realista: "¡Id a comprarlo!". Siendo ya medianoche, sería difícil encontrar una tienda abierta. **La conclusión del mismo Jesús, al final de la historia, es una frase que puede servir de clave para toda la parábola: "Vigilad, pues que no sabéis el día ni la hora". Dios puede venir en cualquier hora de nuestra vida. Todos debemos estar preparados. Como las jóvenes de la boda, todos deben ser prudentes y previsores, llevando cada uno consigo aceite suficiente. O sea, deben estar atentos de no ser causa de descarrilamiento para otros, aunque insistan sobre cosas buenas como el compartir. Deben aprender a estar siempre atentos al servicio que deben dar a Dios y al prójimo.**

## Evangelio - Mt 25, 1-13

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos esta parábola: "El Reino de los cielos es semejante a diez jóvenes, que tomando sus lámparas, salieron al encuentro del esposo. Cinco de ellas eran descuidadas y cinco, previsoras. Las descuidadas llevaron sus lámparas, pero no llevaron aceite para llenarlas de nuevo; las previsoras, en cambio, llevaron cada una un frasco de aceite junto con su lámpara. Como el esposo tardaba, les entró sueño a todas y se durmieron.

A medianoche se oyó un grito: '¡Ya viene el esposo! ¡Salgan a su encuentro!' Se levantaron entonces todas aquellas jóvenes y se pusieron a preparar sus lámparas, y las descuidadas dijeron a las previsoras: 'Dennos un poco de su aceite, porque nuestras lámparas se están apagando'. Las previsoras les contestaron: 'No, porque no va a alcanzar para ustedes y para nosotras. Vayan mejor a donde lo venden y cómprenlo'.

Mientras aquéllas iban a comprarlo, llegó el esposo, y las que estaban listas entraron con él al banquete de bodas y se cerró la puerta. Más tarde llegaron las otras jóvenes y dijeron: 'Señor, señor, ábrenos'. Pero él les respondió: 'Yo les aseguro que no las conozco'.
