ministry had his fair share of run ins with hypocritical people; mostly the religious leaders. I cannot help but notice here that Jesus had little trouble with sinners but had His greatest troubles with the religious leaders of His day, religious leaders who were hypocrites. Jesus did not mince words when it came to religious hypocrisy. That, more than anything else, is what got Him killed. His death was staged by hypocritical religious leaders who Our Blessed Lord exposed to the people under their authority. Today's gospel illustrates such an encounter. Jesus rebukes the Pharisees for placing heavy burdens upon the people and not lifting a finger to help them.

There is always that temptation to be "holy" on Sunday, then Monday through Saturday act in stark contrast with what Jesus expects of us. Christians are easily charged with hypocrisy. The standards set for us are so high that none of us can live up to them – unless we turn to God for help. Which is the whole point, isn't it? What, then, are we to do? The first thing we must do is to realize that we often times fall short of living a life centered on the gospel. We should acknowledge our failings and then, asking for God's mercy, change for the better.

Often, we hold up high expectations of others, holding them to extremely high standards in solving human problems without lifting a finger to help solve those problems ourselves. It's good to have high ideals and high standards in how we live. We need to teach our children to have them and lead them in living out those standards and ideals. But at the same time, we should realize that children are quick, very quick, to see when we are not living up to them ourselves. All of which brings me back to the point: Why are we here? And why do we have our children enrolled in our Religious Education programs? We are here because we realize the importance of having faith. Faith in Jesus; for He forgives us when we falter. He wants us to preach His Gospel and to "practice what we preach."

LETTURE: MI 1,14-2,2b.8-10; Sal 130; 1 Ts 2,7-9.13; Mt 23,1-12
L'AUTENTICITA CRISTIANA

La violenza del linguaggio che Gesù adopera verso quei farisei che si erano seduti sulla cattedra di Mosè può sorprendere, a prima vista, ma è proporzionata alla gravità dello stravolgimento della vita religiosa che essi avevano provocato. Il rimprovero più sferzante che Gesù rivolge loro è quello dell'ipocrisia. Questi farisei erano dei credenti che si erano personalmente impegnati nell'avventura della fede e nella ricostruzione della vita religiosa del loro tempo.

Sapevano benissimo che la fedeltà all'alleanza non si riduce a delle prestazioni culturali, che, al contrario, importa precise esigenze morali. Conoscevano che esistono prescrizioni più importanti della Legge, quelle che riguardano la giustizia e la misericordia. Ma la paura di perdersi e di presentarsi a Dio a mani vuote, li conduceva a cercare all'interno stesso dell'avventura della fede un terreno di sicurezza dove operare la loro giustizia. Per arrivare a questo non c'era nulla di più facile che ridurre la fedeltà a Dio all'osservanza della Legge, la fede alla religione.

A questo punto è possibile scoprirsi automaticamente migliori degli altri; le raffinatezze della casistica permettono di accentuare ancora di più il sentimento di superiorità; gli altri vengono caricati di fardelli insopportabili, mentre si può approfittare delle risorse della casistica per aggirare la legge. Qui l'ipocrisia è manifesta: chi ha spirito farisaico mente a se stesso e inganna gli altri. Egli ha tutta l'apparenza della vera fedeltà a Iahvè, ma in realtà la religione che testimonia è estranea all'avventura della fede, e anziché condurre a Dio gli uomini non fa che attirare gli sguardi su di sé; senza neppure avvedersene egli in tutto ciò che fa cerca soltanto di farsi notare.

REAZIONE DI CRISTO CONTRA L IPOCRISIA

Davanti a simili perversioni si comprende la reazione forte di Gesù. Non c'è niente, infatti, di più estraneo alla religione dell'amore, che il legalismo farisaico col suo corteo di conseguenze. È un atteggiamento e una tentazione corrosiva. Quando nella coscienza del credente si infila il legalismo, il dinamismo proprio dell'avventura della fede viene bloccato, anche se le apparenze sono salve. Oggi siamo invitati, vivere la fede con autenticità, in tal modo che anche ogni espressione religiosa e atti storni diventino un momento particolare di evangelizzazione dentro della comunità cristiana.

Noi siamo cristiani, e con Gesù, ci siamo allontanati dalla casta religiosa dei farisei di allora. Nondimenticare che la speranza cristiana è nata nel cuore di ciascuno di noi. Siamo la religione della interiorità, più al di là della steriorità. La nostra guida è lo spirito di Cristo, non la legge antica. HOMILIA DOMINGO 5 DE NOVIEMBRE

(MATEO. 23,1-12)

La experiencia de Dios, es para ponerla en practica, sino se convierte en obstáculo para los la salvación demás.

La búsqueda de honores acecha a todo el que se encuentra investido de autoridad, de poder. Con frecuencia se provocan situaciones marcadamente ridículas, de las que ni siquiera se dan cuenta los mismos que ofrecen el espectáculo. Haciendo el juego a su increíble inconsciencia, algunos, burlándose, multiplican ante ellos los más exagerados gestos de deferencia. Otros se aprovechan de este gusto inmoderado por las manifestaciones públicas de consideración, por simple adulación servil o para sacar partido: «Todo adulador vive a expensas de quien lo escucha».

A veces, en fin, se exigen señales exteriores de deferencia y títulos honoríficos para hacer sentir a los otros su situación de subordinación, de inferioridad, cuando no para sentirse uno mismo en posesión de la autoridad. Nada de esto debe ocurrir dentro del pueblo de Dios. Los sacerdotes —recuerda con rasgos vigorosos la profecía de Malaquías— tienen la misión de procurar que todos respeten la gloria del «Señor de los ejércitos», «el Gran Rey», y den gloria a su nombre, ante todo por su testimonio de fidelidad a la alianza. Faltando a esta obligación, se convierten en ocasión de tropiezo para muchos.

Entonces Dios no acepta su culto. El pueblo, por su parte, incurre en condena similar cuando, olvidando que Dios es el Padre de todos, profana su nombre con sus disputas e injusticias. Jesús tuvo también palabras muy duras con ciertos escribas y fariseos, que buscaban honores pero olvidaban sus deberes, que cargaban a los otros «fardos pesados e insoportables», pero ellos «no estaban dispuestos a mover un dedo para empujar». San Mateo recuerda estas invectivas del Señor para poner en guardia a los dirigentes de las comunidades cristianas.

A los fieles, escandalizados por tales comportamientos, les recuerda lo que decía el Señor: «Haced y cumplid lo que os digan, pero no hagáis lo que ellos hacen»; «No los aduléis dándoles títulos que sólo a Dios corresponden. Ayudadlos a comportarse como servidores, que es la actitud que realmente debéis tener todos unos con otros».

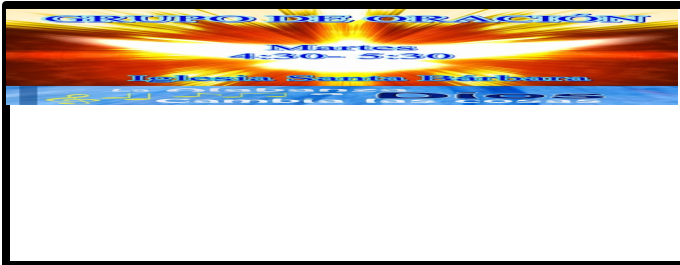
No es en los hombres en quienes se apoya la fe, sino en la palabra de Dios, dice san Pablo, que sigue siendo el modelo perfecto de apóstol, de predicador del Evangelio, de discípulo que consagra su vida al servicio de todos. En la Iglesia todos somos responsables unos de otros.

Un profeta de la segunda mitad del siglo V antes de Cristo, nos dice hoy: Dios ya no puede soportar por más tiempo el modo como algunos sacerdotes celebran el culto y enseñan la Ley, ni la conducta y las disputas e injusticias del pueblo: son profanaciones de la alianza. Os apartasteis del camino y habéis hecho tropezar a muchos en la ley.
